

Golden Time – Years 1 – 6

Each year, in negotiation with their Assistant Head, year groups may wish to employ Golden Time to encourage good pupil behaviour. This will take place on Friday afternoon. If it takes place in one year group, all classes in that year group, across both sites get similar provision.

Sometimes, if a school priority, additional staff (eg AH, Premier Sports, external agencies) may be timetabled to support this.

Once it has been agreed for a year group, fun activities can be planned.

Whether or not a child gets golden time will be dependent on how they have responded to our Rule Reminder system.

Each KSR decides its system for rewarding Golden Time and this is clearly explained to the class each year.

An example is as follows:

Children who get no more than one rule reminder each day = All Golden Time.

Children who get no more than one rule reminder on at least 3 days will get the first half of their Golden time only.

Golden Time activities are fun, well planned and age appropriate.

If possible, the activities may lead to a defined outcome.

The SLT will organise drop-ins and observations to ensure the quality of the provision.

Children missing their Golden Time in Year 3 – 6 will spend their time in a detention room. A child who regularly attends detention may be subject to a behaviour plan which will be shared with parents.
