### Uniform Policy

At Roding Primary School, we have a school uniform which allows all children to have a sense of pride and identity with our school and its values. The expectation is that all children will wear our agreed uniform each day.

#### Uniform:

Navy blue jumper or cardigan, white polo shirt or white shirt, navy blue trousers or knee-length skirt, navy blue tights and black shoes (with no visible logos). White, black or navy blue sock, no socks with bright colours or patterns on them.

Summer option: navy blue knee length shorts or blue and white check dress.

Roding Primary School jumpers are available from our office at both sites.

We strongly encourage children's names to be written on the labels inside of their uniforms.

#### Headscarves/hijab:

We invite children to wear these as part of their religious beliefs although we do ask that they be in our school colours – navy blue or white.

#### Kippar:

We invite children to wear these as part of their religious beliefs.

#### Dastar:

We invite children to wear these as part of their religious beliefs although we do ask that it be in our school colours – navy blue or white.

#### Other religious clothing:

For any other enquiries regarding religious clothing, please liaise directly with the site headteacher.

#### Hair:

Children with long hair may wish to use a hair band, hair clips or small bows. Hair bands or bows should be in the school colours of either navy blue or white. Large bows or clip bows are not to be worn.

Roding Primary School has adopted the Halo Code which is the UK's first black hair code. As part of this, we champion the rights of staff and students to embrace all afro-hairstyles.

### Bags:

Children should bring a book bag with them to school every day. The child's name should be written on the inside of the book bag. Due to limited classroom or hallway space, children should not bring in rucksacks or large bags.

Roding Primary School book bags are available from our school office at both sites.

### PE Kit:

White t-shirt or polo shirt, navy sports shorts, black plimsolls and navy tracksuit bottoms as an additional option. We strongly encourage parents to write their child's name on the labels with PE kits.

### PE bags:

As PE kits are usually kept in school during the term, children should use a small drawstring with the name of the child written on the inside of the bag.

Roding primary School drawstring PE bags are available from our school office at both sites.

### Jewellery:

Children may wear stud earrings only, no hoop or hanging earrings are to be worn to school. For safety reasons, earrings must be removed by the children for PE lessons (they must be able to remove earrings without any adult supervision).

Any other form of jewellery including necklaces and bangles are not allowed.

Make up and nail varnish may not be worn in school.
