Safeguarding our children and ensuring that all children feel valued and included, remains our priority. Here are a few things which we have in place to support this:

- A dedicated, cross site Safeguarding Team
- A Family Liaison Practitioner at each site to support individual children and families (Mrs Caden- Cannington and Mrs Roberts- Hewett)
- Thrive Practitioners (Mrs Graves, Mrs Donovan and Miss Lumi) who work across the school providing pastoral support for individual children and groups of children
- Lunchtime Club for children who wish to access a quieter space
- Playground Squad and Referees who support children at lunchtime and support with leading enjoyable games
- Weekly assemblies whereby children are reminded of the Roding Values, Equalities and the expectations for behaviour
- 'Have a Say' boxes, whereby children can write a note to a Thrive Practitioner/Learning Mentor
- A well sequenced PSHE curriculum, whereby children learn about how to stay safe and how to be a good friend






